Explanatory Notes

Definition of Grades

- ▷ The results of the GCSE examinations are reported on an 8 point scale of Grades: A*(a*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) and G(g).
- ▷ Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard for a subject receive no grade and a subject receiving no grade is not recorded on the certificate.

Double Award Specifications

- ▷ The results in these specifications are reported on the 15 point scale of Grades A*A*(a*a*), A*A(a*a), AA(aa), AB(ab), BB(bb), BC(bc), CC(cc), CD(cd), DD(dd), DE(de), EE(ee), EF(ef), FF(ff), FG(fg), GG(gg) of which Grade A*A* is the highest and Grade GG is the lowest. Results in these specifications have the same status as GCSE grades in two other single-certification subjects.

Short Courses

- ▷ The Short Course is designed to cover not less than half the specification content of the corresponding full GCSE subject course of study and the same grading standards are applied. The GCSE (Short Course) is, therefore, broadly equivalent to half the corresponding full GCSE.


